GUIDELINES FOR PREPARING SCIENTIFIC ORAL PRESENTATIONS

Presentation Length

Oral presentations will be allotted 8 minutes for their presentation and questions session will be at the end of all presentations. Presenters are expected to strictly keep up the timing.

Slides

There is no restriction on the number of slides. Having a maximum of 16 slides (2 slides/ minute) shall ensure that the contents are delivered at an optimal speed. The content slides should cover briefly the background, aim and objectives, methodology, results (specific key findings), discussion and take home message.

Slide Format

Please ensure that all presentations are in MS PowerPoint as our system supports the same. Also the background/ foreground color combination need to be checked for good contrast in the presentation mode. Avoid Grey background and light colored fonts.

Acknowledgements and conflicts of interest need to be mentioned at the end of the presentation.

Slide Submission

All presenters should email their presentations to evmemorial@snmail.org by the 20th February, 10.00 am. Due to the tightly packed schedule, presenters will not be allowed to load their presentations at the venue. Only the presentations that reach us by the deadline will be recommended for presentation.

GUIDELINES FOR PREPARING CLINICIAN TO RESEARCHER PRESENTATIONS

Presentation Length

The clinician to researcher oral presentations will be allotted 8 minutes for their presentation and questions session will be at the end of all presentations. Presenters are expected to strictly keep up the timing.

Slides

There is no restriction on the number of slides. Having a maximum of 16 slides (2 slides/ minute) shall ensure that the contents are delivered at an optimal speed. The content slides should cover briefly the background, case details, clinical findings, management and take home message.

Most important: What is the research question that you want to evolve from this case? This should come out well at the end of the presentation

Slide Format

Please ensure that all presentations are in MS PowerPoint as our system supports the same. Also the background/ foreground color combination need to be checked for good contrast in the presentation mode. Avoid Grey background and light colored fonts.

Ensure that necessary clinical images and photographs (without revealing the identity of the patient) are to be used
