ORIGINAL RESEARCH ORAL PRESENTATION: GUIDELINES

Presentation Length

Presenters will be allotted 6 minutes for an oral presentation and 4 minutes for questions.

Preparation of Slides

A maximum of 20 slides shall ensure that the contents are delivered at an optimal speed. The slides should contain the title, authors and affiliation, Abstract ID, brief background, aim and objectives, methodology, salient results, discussion and conclusion. References and funding agency should be quoted in the slides. Acknowledgements and conflicts of interest has to be mentioned at the end of the presentation.

Slide Format

All presentations should be prepared in MS PowerPoint. Kindly ensure that a legible font size is followed.

Submission of Slides

Presenters should mail their slides in .ppt or .pptx format to evmemorial@snmail.org on or before 10th March, 2026 by 5.00 PM in the following format:

Please note: Presenters will not be allowed to load their presentations at the last minute. Only the presentations that reach us by the deadline will be considered for evaluation.

CASE REPORT ORAL PRESENTATIONS: GUIDELINES

Presentation Length

Presenters will be allotted 5 minutes for an oral presentation and 3 minutes for questions.

Preparation of Slides

A maximum of 10 slides shall ensure that the contents are delivered at an optimal speed. The slides should contain the title, authors and affiliation, Abstract ID, brief background, case details, clinical findings, management, discussion and a take home message. References should be quoted in the slides. Acknowledgements and conflicts of interest has to be mentioned at the end of the presentation.

Slide Format

All presentations should be prepared in MS PowerPoint. Kindly ensure that a legible font size is followed. Ensure that necessary clinical images and photographs (without revealing the identity of the patient/subject) are present.


Submission of Slides

E-POSTER GUIDELINES

Slide Format

The presentation template provided in the website should be used for preparing the slides. Kindly ensure that a legible font size is followed.

Dimensions: length 59cm x width 42cm

Preparation of Slide

The e-poster should contain the title, authors and affiliation, Abstract ID, brief background, aim and objectives, methodology, salient results, discussion and conclusion. References should be quotes in the text and listed at the last section. Acknowledgements and conflicts of interest has to be mentioned at the end.

Submission of Poster

Presenters should mail their poster in PDF format to evmemorial@snmail.org on or before 10th March, 2026 by 5.00 PM in the following format:
